ATTENTION

Before any outdoor bonfire is conducted, the property owner shall inspect the location and site area and confirm that precautions have been taken to prevent fire in accordance with NFPA 1 and an approved site plan establishing approved safe area in accordance with this permit for open bonfires.

The Fire Marshal or representative shall have the authority to prohibit any and or all open fires when atmospheric conditions or local circumstances make such fires hazardous.

NOTE: The permit shall be available on site for inspection by Fire Department or Law Enforcement personnel. This permit shall be revoked if any violation of the applicable Code or General Precautions are found upon inspection or in case there have been any false statements of misrepresentations submitted in the application or plans on which the permit or approval was based.
