## Requirements to Obtain a Dock, Boat Lift, Mooring Piles or Swim/Observation Platform Permit

- 1. **Completed Building Permit Application**. Please make sure that you clearly indicate the type of construction, and real estate number of property, and the name and license number of the contractor (if applicable).
- 2. Letter of Approval from the owner of the property if the lessee desires to perform the work.
- 3. A **Recent Survey** of the property.
- 4. Three (3) copies of a **Site Plan** showing the water body, dimensions of the lot and canal (if applicable), all existing structures on the property, and the location of the proposed dock, boat lift, or mooring piles.
- 5. Three (3) copies of **Sealed Engineered Drawings**.
- 6. Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) Approval or Exemption Letter.
- 7. Army Corps of Engineers (ACOE) Permit.

## All docks, boat lifts, and mooring piles must comply with the following:

- 1. The terminal end must have at least four (4) foot water depth at Mean Low Water (MLW).
- 2. If construction is proposed on a canal:
  - a. The dock together with a moored vessel can not exceed more than 25% of the width of the navigable canal.
- 3. If the construction is proposed on property with a mangrove fringe:
  - a. The dock must be designed using a "T" or "L" dock
  - b. The walkway connecting the dock to the shore shall not exceed four (4) feet.
- 4. For pier type dock along open water:
  - a. Such structures are oriented approximately perpendicular to the shoreline.
  - b. No structure shall be longer than the linear shoreline frontage of the parcel subject to a maximum of one hundred (100) feet.
  - c. Cannot terminate over sea grasses or hard bottom communities.
  - d. A benthic survey is required

## All Swim/Observation Platforms must comply with the following:

- 1. All structures shall be approximately perpendicular to the shoreline.
- 2. Such structures shall not be used for docking purposes and will be designed to deter or restrict the structure for boating use.
- 3. Structures must terminate in water no deeper than six (6) inches at MLW or begin the terminal platform no further than ten (10) feet beyond water ward extent of mangroves.
- 4. Where a terminal platform is proposed, the platform cannot exceed 160 square feet.
- 5. Cannot terminate over sea grasses or hard bottom communities.
- 6. A benthic survey is required.
